

Privacy Disclaimer for Conference Registration – RestartIL. Economy. Berlin

This privacy disclaimer governs how BENNY MORAN PRODUCTUON OF CONFERENCES CULTURAL&BUSINESS EVENT LTD. **RestartIL**” and/or **“we”**) uses, collects, and stores the personal data that we collect or receive from or about you when you register for the conference to be held in Berlin on February 29 (**“Conference”**). By registering for the Conference, you agree to the following terms regarding your personal data:

1. **Personal Data Collection and Use:** The personal data collected during registration, such as name, email address, professional details, etc., will be used for organizing and managing the conference. This includes communication, updates, and logistical arrangements. Of course, you are not required to supply any of the information that we may request. However, failure to do so may result in our being unable to register you for the conference.
2. **Audio and Visual Recording:** Photographs and/or audio-visual footage may be taken and/or live-streamed during (part of) the Conference. Photos and videos can be published on RestartIL's websites and social media pages, as well as on the co-organizer's online platforms. Photos and videos may also be recorded and can be reproduced in various media including RestartIL publications, social networks, and press, in connection with a specific event, or for further institutional purposes as well as for promotional activities of RestartIL. By attending the Conference, you agree that you may appear in published photos and/or videos as stated above.
3. **Data Sharing:** Your data may be shared with selected startups, exhibitors, and third-party service providers (such as hotels or advertisers) involved in the conference, both within and outside the EU. When transferring your personal data outside of the European Economic Area (EEA), we generally obtain contractual commitments from the recipients to protect your personal data. In engaging in such transfers, we rely on either: i) Adequacy Decisions adopted by the European Commission (for example, when accessing data from Israel), or ii) Standard Contractual Clauses. The sharing of your data will be limited to what is necessary for the successful execution of the Conference.
4. **Opt-In for Communication:** For all communications, we adhere to an opt-in policy, ensuring we have explicit consent. This applies to both personal and business email addresses. We will maintain records of consent, and you can withdraw your consent at any time.
5. **Right to be Forgotten:** You have the right to have your personal data erased from our records (**“Right to be Forgotten”**). On request, we will remove your data from all our databases and cease further contact, unless you opt back in through our opt-in process.
6. **Data Portability and Access:** You have the right to access your data, request corrections, and transfer your data to another controller (**“Data Portability”**). We will provide this data in a digital format upon request.
7. **Data Protection and Security:** We are committed to the security of your personal data and have implemented appropriate measures to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction.
8. **Data Retention:** Your data will be retained only as long as necessary for the purposes stated, in line with our data retention policies and GDPR. Limited data may be kept longer for archiving and historical purposes.
